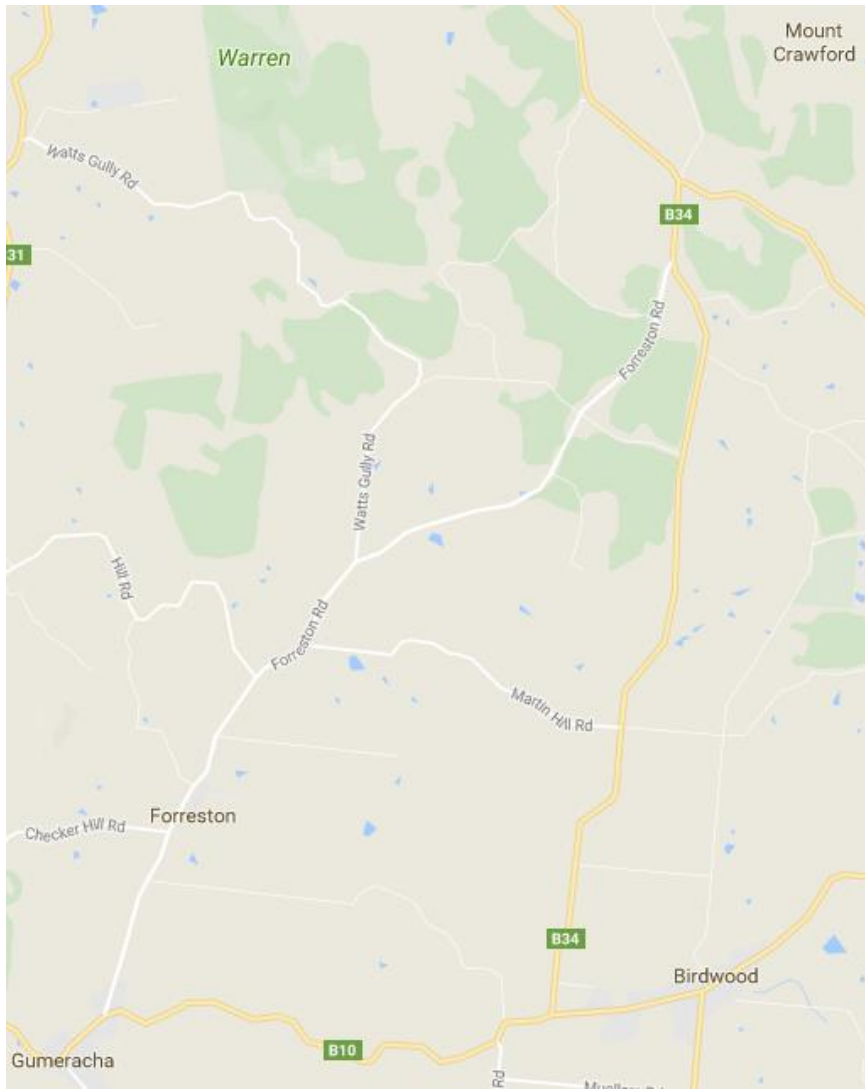
We'll supply the sausages and sweets; you may wish to bring along a salad or nibbles to share – anyone for marshmallows to toast on the fire?
