## BEST IN SHOW – Ch Naragold Paradiso RUNNER UP BEST & OPPOSITE IN SHOW – Ch Chaleur Hubba Bubb

### Restricted Obedience Trial – Judge Mr Roger Green

5 Entries unfortunately & No qualifiers.

I would take this opportunity to thank the committee of the GRC of SA for inviting me to judge your 2014 Golden Retriever Specialty show, and the great hospitality shown. We realy enjoyed our time in Adelaide and having the honour to judge your beautiful golden retrievers.

I also want to thank all the exhibitors who entered under me and even when your dog was not one of the winners - you always take the best dog home. It was only my humble opinion on the day over your dogs as presented on the day.

I had some really, very lovely golden retrievers which could easily gain top honours in Europe. I want to congratulate my winners, I really thought you were great specimens of the breed.

Generally I thought that some of the weaknesses were in the return of upperarm and sometimes just the lack of balance. Some kennels probably have some of these faults heavily inbeded in their breeding lines and that is really something to watch for.

My critiques about the dogs as presented on the day:

#### Baby Puppy dog:

1st. Reimann's Bournbeay My Jasperson Angus - Mature puppy for age. Good double coat in a lovely rich color of gold. Pleasing head wth good expression, strong neck of good length flowing into level topline. Very well boned. Sufficiently, equally angulated front and behind. Covered the ground well on the move.

2nd. Wallis's Boolaroo Basil Brush – A Much younger baby than one. Apealing head and expression. Lovely bone. Would prefer better angles front and behind. Well sprung ribs. Little crouching over the croup which affected his movement.

#### Puppy dog:

1st. Thompson's Chaleur Maximilian. Very flashy dog. Appealing head with soft eye and expression. Excellent reach of neck leading into well laid back shoulders, good return of upperarm for age. Level topline and tailset. Excellent quarters, which he used to his advantage at the move, giving a super ground covering action. Attractive pale coat .Very well presented.

2nd. Johns's Goldmartini Hells Full So I'm Back – very different in type to one, would prefer better front angulation, lacked in overall balance which showed on the move. Good head, Topline could be straighter.

#### Junior dog:

1st. Wallis's Boolaroo Macindoe Bruce. Dog of a good size with a good head with well defined stop and dark eye. Strong neck, rather heavy over the shoulder, would prefer a better layback of the blade, which showed on the move in a shorter front action. Would prefer more bend of stifle. Topline sloping. Good bone, well sprung ribs, in good coat, well presented.

#### Intermediate dog:

1st. Thompson's Ch.Chaleur Hilfiger – Excellent breed type, super outline and balance.

Should still develop in body and substance with age. Very pleasing head, Excellent neck flowing into well laid back shoulders. Animated male with clean lines and excellent quarters which he used to produce an excellent ground covering action.

2nd. Fuller & Martin's Goldmartini You can Kiss This - Excellent type, well made dog, Good head with soft expression, Good neck, would prefer a little better layback of shoulder, excellent bone and spring of rib, good coat, well presented and covered the ground well on the move.

3rd. Murphy's Majik Macavity.- Pleasing type, unfortunately a little unsettled in the ring. Pleasing, kind head and good expression. Adequate neck, Would prefer a better layback of shoulder. Well developed body. Good bone. Front and rear could be slighty more straight in stance. Level topline, excellent coat.

#### State bred dog

1st. Joseph's Ch.Baradav Law N Order – Excellent type, good head with the right expression. Excellent angulation at both ends. Good forechest. Good depth of rib. Croup rounded which spoils his topline, but nevertheless still a quality male. Good ground covering action on the move in which he used his quarters to his advantage, well presented in gleaming gold coat.

2nd. Williams Ch.Haydengold High Hopes – Attractive dog with pretty head, good strong neck flowing into well laid back shoulder, would prefer a little better return of upperarm, good hindquarters which he used to his advantage on the move, slightly falling over the croup.

3rd. Reimann's Ch. Bournbeau Tartan Bruce – Classical type, strong masculine head with a deep muzzle, a little light in eye which spoils the expression. Strong neck, strong, level topline. Balanced in his construction. Good mover . In good coat, with plenty of feathering.

#### Australian bred dog

1st. Stephens, Handley and Platt's Giltedge Cat Got Your Tongue – Lovely type with a most pleasing well chiseled head, Excellently made and balanced throughout, great reach of neck, giving super head carriage. Well angulated front and behind. Strong topline. Would prefer a little bit more drive on the move. Should have a a great future.

2nd. Sommer's Ch.Dobro Arcade Fire - Excellent breed type, masculine with very pleasing head and expression. In good coat. Very well made throughout, unfortunate to meet 1 in this class. Excellent quarters which enabled him to move well with a ground covering action. Would prefer a more level topline.

3rd. Breen's Goldmartini Refusal May Offend - Smaller dog, more compact and short coupled. Good head and expression. Would prefer a little longer neck and a better layback of shoulder, Well developed body, excellent coat, not completely straight in topline which shows on the move.

#### Open dog

1st. Clark's Ch.Naragold Paradiso – The star of the day, loved everything about him, well chisseled head with super sweet and soft expression. A quality, waggy, happy boy with a great character, attitude and ring presence. Love his reach of neck, well laid back shoulders, superb front assembly, level topline, great angles at his back end, and his long easy, effortless ground covering action. Very pleased to award him Best dog and BOB.

2nd. Handley and Petterwood's Ch. Larbellah Team Leader – a great dog in every point. And very typical to look at. Super balance, different as one, but a very close contender for the top honours! Lovely head with a soft, friendly expression. Good, strong neck flowing into well laid back shoulders, good return of upperarm. Deep through the heart, excellent spring of rib, Lovely deep rich golden coat. Good back end. Dead level topline and tailset. Makes a great picture stood and on the move. Covered the ground well with a powerful stride, and good head and tail carriage. Reserve Best Dog.

3rd. Murphy's Ch.Baradav Murphys Law – well made dog, of good body proportions, in super coat. Would prefer a little longer leg. Very well developed body with well sprung ribs, and lovely angles front and behind. Pleasing typical head, level, strong back but slightly sloping over the croup. Moved with plenty of drive and an easy stride.

#### Veteran dog

1st Thompson's Supreme Ch.Chaleur Valentino - 7 year old dog of an excellent type, quality and construction, presented in great condition. The sweetest of heads with excellent pigmentation. Excellent neck and head carriage. Lovely balance and outline, super, straight front, pretty coat, super ringpresence, attitude and animation. Excellent ground covering action. Great champion dog.

2nd. Joseph's Grand Ch. Baradav Flying Solo – Good classical type, Lovely head and expression, Good neck, well laid back shoulders, straight legs, well bent stifles, little dipping behind the whithers, correct level tailset, moved with drive and good ground covering action.

#### **Bitches**

#### **Baby Pupy bitch**

1st. Breen's Goldntropics Picture Perfect – Lovely 3 months old promising puppy. Sweet, well shaped head with well placed eyes giving her a very soft expression. Excellent pigmentation. Good neck. Straight front. Well angulated front and behind. Ample bone, nice feet, level topline. Still rather impressed with the whole situation on the move. But moved sufficiently and with drive. Pleased to award her Best Baby Puppy.

#### Minor puppy

1st. Thompson's Chaleur Naughty But Nice – Very elegant and stylish pale bitch, Very feminine head with a lovely expression. Long clean neck flowing into well laid back shoulder. Straight front. Level topline, lovely coat, would prefer a little more return of upperarm, well angulated behind, showed a good stride with a good ground covering action, still needs to develop in body.

2nd. Breen's Goldntropics Tinkerbell - Very different in type to 1. Appealing puppy with good depth and substancefor age. And a well sprung ribcage. Excellent bone and already well developed body. Sweet head with good expression, Strong neck of good length. Would prefer a little better angulation at the front. Good strong back end. Covered the ground well for age.

3rd. Pickard's Chaleur Nardia ov Papeta - Very feminine puppy, with a feminine head, good expression. and kind eye. Good neck. Straight front. Would prefer a better angulation at both ends, which hopefully improves with maturity. Would prefer more substance, better spring of rib, depth of body and stronger bone, could show more power and drive on the move.

#### Puppy bitch

1st. Kelton's Goldstreem Sheer Majik – Very well made, but longer cast bitch with a good feminine head, Lovely neck and shoulders, good return of upperarm, Strong hindquarters. Excellent body, Held her topline well on the move with good head and tail carriage. Moved out to advantage with a free and easy stride, which won her the class as a close decission between 1 and 2.

2nd. Thompson's Chaleur Madam Butterfly - another very typical and lovely specimen of our breed .More puppylike and looser than 1.Very sweet head good expression, good strong neck, level topline, excellent bone, gorgeous coat. Excellent shoulder and retrurn of upperarm, well sprung ribs, excellent tailset, sufficient bend of stiffle.

Covered the ground very well but needs to tighten as still quite roly on the move.

3rd. Wood's Aurumgold Electric Dreams – Well sized feminine bitch, good head and expression. Lovely reach of neck flowing into well laid back shoulders. Excellent angulated front and behind. Straight legs with excellent bone. Little long

over the loin, excellent tailset, excellent length of stride and covered the ground well.

#### Junior bitch

1st. Handley's Giltedge There's A Butterfly – strong, feminine bitch of excellent breed type. Well proportioned and well made throughout. Matured in body for age. shorter coupled. Very pleasing and well chisseled head, Good strong neck flowing into well laid back shoulder. Straight front. Good forechest and excellent return of upperarm putting her legs well under the body. Level topline and good tailset. Strong well angulated rear giving lots of drive and a powerful stride. Good and efficient groundcovering action.

2nd. Fuller and Martin's Zenevieva Stop Lookin I'm Here Lovely type of bitch making a pleasing picture when stood. Longer cast than 1, Very sweet head with lovely expression. Lovely neck, shoulders rather steep, though a good return of upperarm, Very well sprung ribs and deep through the heart. good bend of stifle, excellent level tailset.. Unfortunatly not sound on the move behind today.

3rd. Wallis Boolaroo Ginger Megs – Unfortunately hard to handle in the showring and difficult to asses. Not completely typical for the breed. Lacked in her overall construction; short in neck with high set shoulder and inadequate front, short in ribbing and untypical head expression. In full coat which made her looking even more compact and low on the legs. Good character, but needs ringcraft.

#### Intermediate bitch

1st. Stephens Ch.Fetchpoint You and Whose Army - Depicts excellent breed type and symmetry. Well developed and of good size and substance but still feminine. Very well presented, in super coat and condition. Gorgeous head and expression, superb neck and head carriage ,Superb layback of shoulder with a good front assembly. excellent bone, very well angulated behind. Good length of stride, would prefer a little more drive on the move.

2nd. Wallis Calendula the Cleaning Lady Well sized bitch would prefer a litle stronger head with bit more filling under the eyes, good pigmentation but a little light in eye. Strong neck, rather upright in shoulder and upperarm, straight front ,good bone, well developed body, excellent bend of stiffle which she uses to her advantage on the move, good strong topline with a level tailset.

Nelder's Chaleur Its All About Me – Very feminine bitch, feminine head with good pigmentation and soft expression. Would prefer better angulation front and behind. Hence a rather short stride. Straight front, sufficient bone but want to see better spring of rib and depth of body. Lacks substance.

#### State bred bitch

1st.Williams Ch.Haydengold One Step Ahead – Very pleasing bitch to see. Very sweet head and expression, strong yet very feminine. Very well made throughout and of a lovely breed type. Lovely reach of neck flowing into well laid back shoulders, excellent angulation front and behind, straight legs, level topline with good tailset. Showed a good driving stride on the move. Well deserved class winner.

2nd.Bourn's Bournbeau Matilda in Tartan - Good solid bitch of a classical type. A little course in head for me with a lighter eye which spoils the expression. Balanced in her angulation front and behind. Strong neck set into good clean shoulders. Well bodied with well sprung ribs , strong loin, level topline, good bone. Moved OK. Would prefer more drive.

3rd. Nelder's Sambindor Sheer Angelic Spirit - Nice bitch of a good type. which lacks power and animation. Good head and expression. Good neck and lay back of shoulder with good return of upperarm. Sufficient bone and spring of rib, would prefer a little more bend of stiffle and more reach and drive on the move.

#### Australian bred bitch

1st. Thompson's Ch.Chaleur Hubba Bubba – Wonderful eye catching bitch of excellent breed type, Most lovely head and expression. attractive blonde coat of good quality. Excellent in her construction throughout with everything where you would want it! Well bodied with plenty of substance. Superb in her spring of rib, depth of body, topline and tailset; loved her! Moved with style and drive, must have a great future.

2nd. Parkridge kennels Parkridge Legally Blonde – very well made bitch full of quality and breed type, beautiful feminine head, Superb reach of neck. Lovely layback of shoulder. Very well angulated front and behind, Excellent bone, lovely body with well sprung ribs. Muscular bitch in good hard condition, with good second thighs. Excellent level topline, super tailset. good groundcovering movement.

3rd. Clark's Ch.Naragold Dreamer – Lovely stylish feminine bitch of excellent breed type. Pretty, sweet head and expression, lovely length of neck flowing ino well laid back shoulders, most excellent topline and dead level tailset, well angulated front and behind. Straight legs fore and aft. Would prefere a little more depth of body. Covered the ground very well, on the move but a little rolling in the body. An excellent class with Three wonderful examples of our breed.

#### Open bitch

1st. Thompson's - Ch.Chaleur Catwalk Good sized, matured, quality bitch of lovely type. Feminine head with a soft and sweet expression. Very well presented in pretty coat with good feathering. Great body proprtions, with superb neck and flow, beautifully angulated front and behind, excellent depth of body, great bone, and plenty of substance. Moved well and with style.

2nd. Handley's Ch.Giltedge Sister Act – Great bitch in shape, Lovely strong neck flowing into well laid back shoulders, excellent return of upperarm, good bone, well developed body with excellent spring of rib, strong loin, strong level topline, super tailset., could move with a little more animation and drive.

3rd. Kelton's Ch.Majik Trulie Julie – Very well made typical, pretty, feminine bitch, close contendor to one and two. Good head, lovely balance, superb length of neck, great angles, good topline, superb in body and ribbing, excellent bone, lovely dense, double coat, well presented, good groundcovering action. Lovely bitch.

#### Neuter bitch

1st. Wood's Ch.Fantango Silver Belle CD. Good type, sweet head, soft expression, straight front, deep through the heart, little heavy on shoulders, sufficient bend of stifle, good proportions, level topline with correct tail set, moved correctly with drive, loving her day out.

2nd. Joseph's Ch.Baradav Framed in Gold - Good type, sweet head with kind expression, excellent neck, slightly sloping over the withers, little weak in topline, excellent depth of body, sufficient bone, would like a little better bend of stifle, Covered the ground well on the move.

Again a special congratulation to my top 4 winning dogs which are all great typical representatives of our beloved breed even though varying in appearance and different in breed type. To Ch.Naragold Paradiso and Ch.Larabellah Team Leader, Both great dogs on themselves – you made my heart smile. My two winning bitches were very lovely and feminine. Ch.Chaleur Hubba Bubba, with her most lovely outline, Giltedge Theres's a Butterfly a little more compact and stronger, again two different bitches who gave me great pleasure to award them the top honours.
